




- This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a licensed electrician familiar with the construction and operation of the product and hazards involved.

Step A


1. Mount housing to structure using included hanger bars. Mount housing so that face of throat is 3/8" A.F.F. or from face of ceiling.





Step D

1. Install ceiling ensuring the center of the cut-out aligns with center of housing throat.




Step E

1. Install mud flange by threading flange clockwise into throat until flange is flush against ceiling. Install 3/4" long drywall screws through coutnersink holes in plaster flange.




Step F

1. Finish ceiling, including mudding or plastering mud flange. (Take care not to get paint or joint compound inside opening of mud flange.)




Step G

1. After ceiling is finished, remove installed aperture plug.




Step H

1. Push trim into opening until ball plungers catch the retainers.



Step I

 Remove trim by pulling downward on trim until ball plungers disengage from retainers.



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
